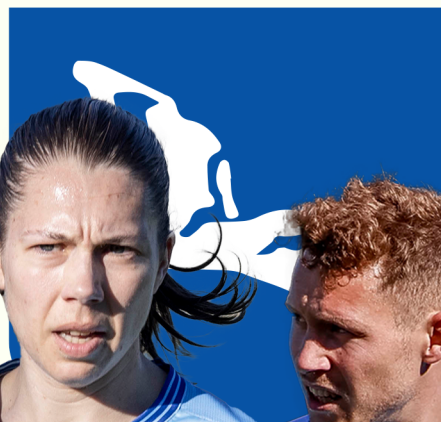

Mini Football

Players play in increasing number groups (5v5; 7v7; 9v9) and are beginning to focus on technical and tactical learning with their coach. They will have 1 training and 1 game each week. These are the “skill-hungry” years. Motivationally, children are geared to learn skills at this time, providing an ideal opportunity for building football-specific skills into fundamental movement abilities.
